Thanks for getting all your forms back in. On Friday of last week we had another great assembly. There was some excellent information learnt and explained to the audience about the severity of waste in the world. It is great to see Lake Wangary children doing their part to help reduce waste in the world. It is hoped that this continues on, not only at school but in our homes. We are trying new things at home to be more respectful of the environment. It's a great feeling knowing you are you helping. If you are concerned with the speed of trucks past your homes during pick up or drop off, please record the number plate and report to authorities. If we have a strong voice in this area, the Council and DPTI will have to act and put bus signs up around stops which we deserve to have. I have fought for this during the year and hit walls. Some statistics on speeding vehicles past buses will be great evidence to get things done and ensure safe pick up and drop off times and zones.

There has been some conjecture around the preschool next year. I would like to advise parents that the preschool IS OPEN next year. Yehaa! It will run as per normal with one slight extra, our Support Program will run in conjunction with the preschool Students who turn 4 after the 1st of May. These students will be attending for 2 half days or 1 full day. This will help boost our numbers and allow local students to experience preschool. It will also help their socialisation by having more unique cherubs in our preschool.
