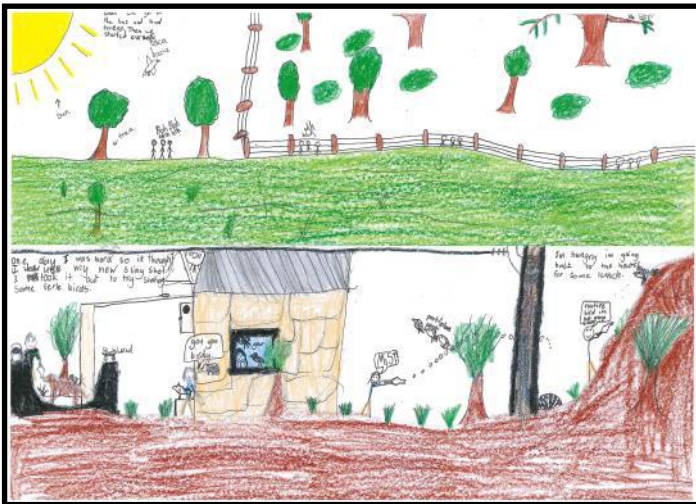
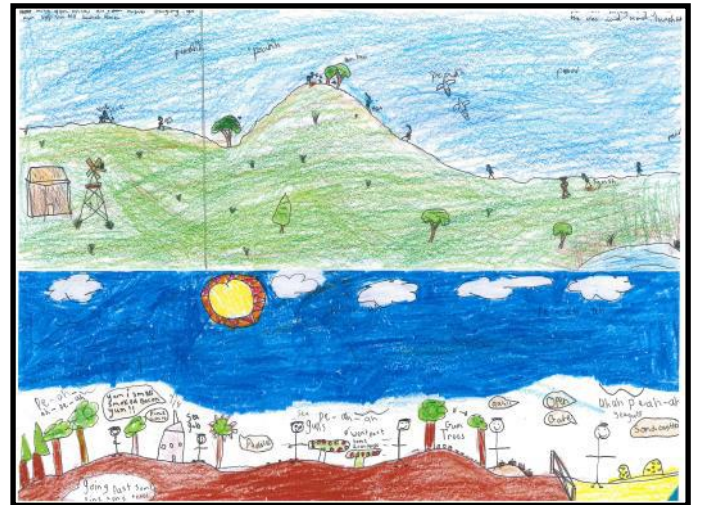
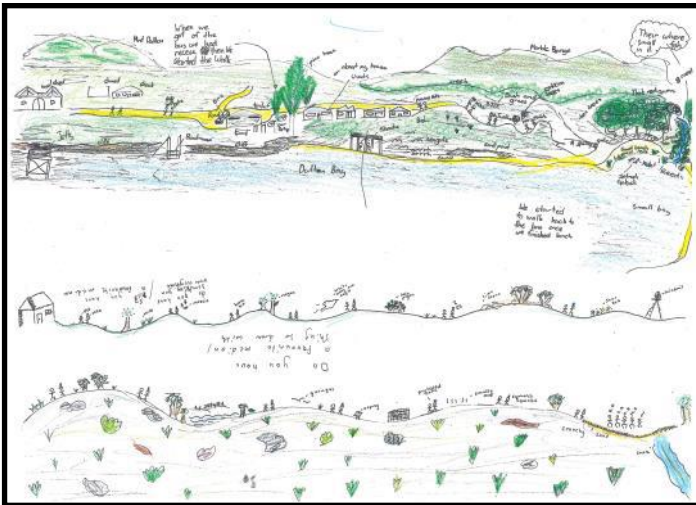
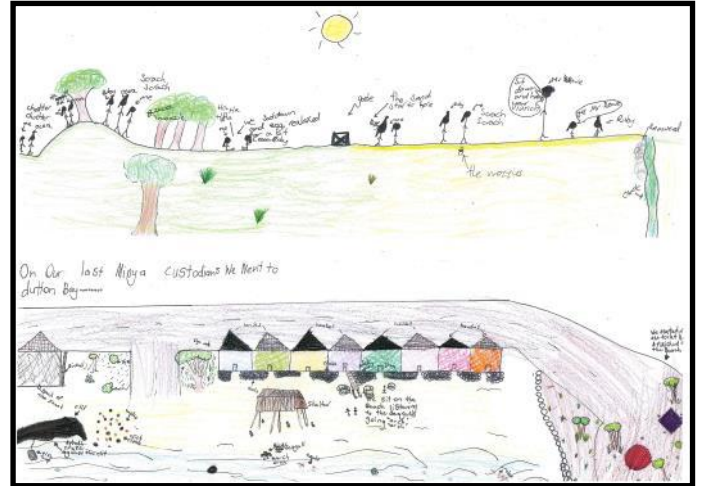
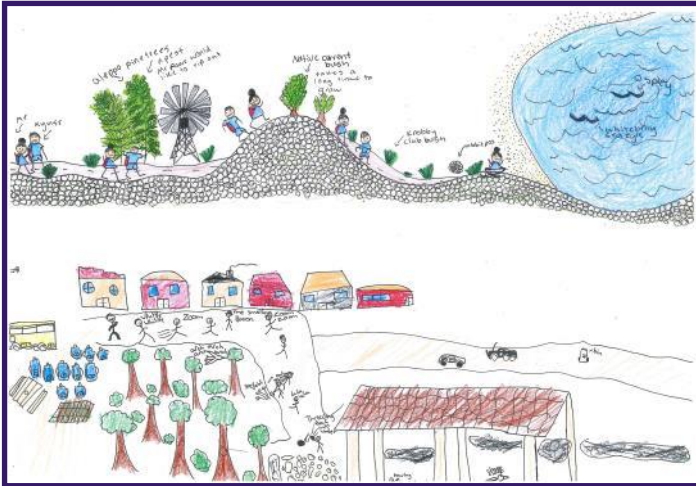




# Lake Wangary School Newsletter

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

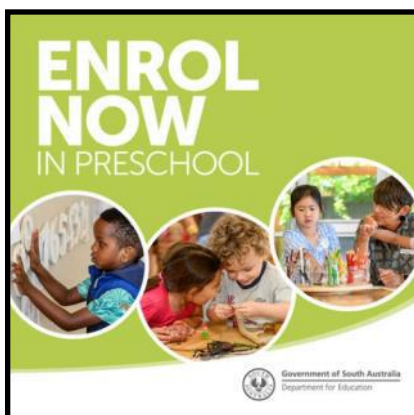
