Tessellations



Students in the Upper Primary class have been experimenting with tessellations. Tessellations or tessellating occurs when a shape is moved and reused repetitively on a page to create unique designs and pictures. Students began with simple shapes and are now looking at creating their own shapes to create a tessellated picture. Have a look at Kyuss' first attempt. Sea-ana has used a diamond shape to create a picture that looks like stacked cubes. Students are learning how to draw 3D pictures through using tessellations. If you look online and search 'famous tessellations' you can see some of the amazing work by M.C. Escher. They are really cool. The one with the ducks flying in both directions looks great. Well done on creating these, your next ones will be even better.
