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Students copied photos of landscapes and built them from plasticine. They are all creative and look amazing.



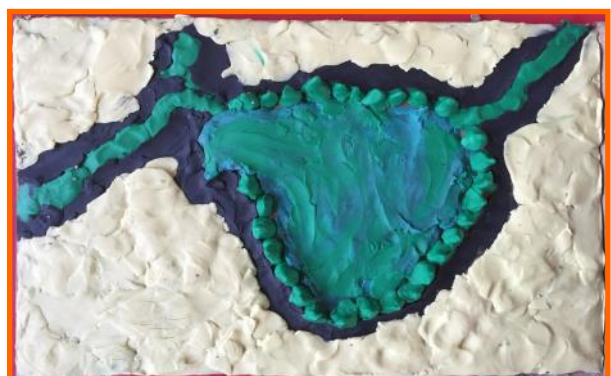
Waterholes
The rivers dry up and leave behind waterholes. This waterhole/lake has lots of water because it has underground water.

Sand dunes
Sand dunes start off as a beach, then the wind comes and blows the sand up into a mound and this makes the sand dunes.



Rivers
Rivers are curved because the water pushes against the soft rock and erodes it to make a curve. When they curve too far they can join and make a Waterhole or a horse shoe shape. The water comes from the lakes and mountains.

Lakes
Lakes form by rivers going into a horse shoe shape. The water flows through and eventually makes a large lake. The water stays in the hole.

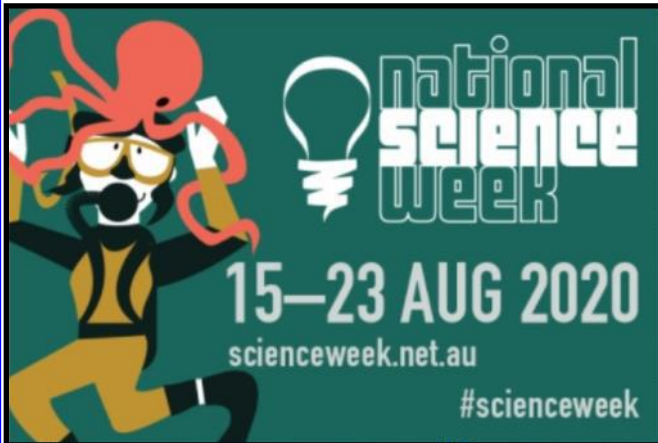
