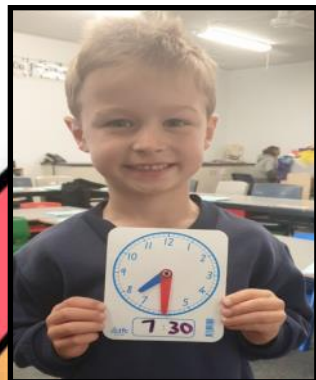




Lake Wangary School Newsletter

From the beginning of Term 3 in the Junior Primary Class our Maths focus has been "friends of ten/rainbow facts" and "telling the time to the half hour". In this activity students were asked to use the blocks to demonstrate a rainbow fact. Rainbow facts are two numbers that add up to 10. They were able to show their understanding by using the blocks to show these two numbers. Students in the telling the time task were given a written time and were required to demonstrate on the clocks. Students were able to show their understanding of time using different manipulatives.
