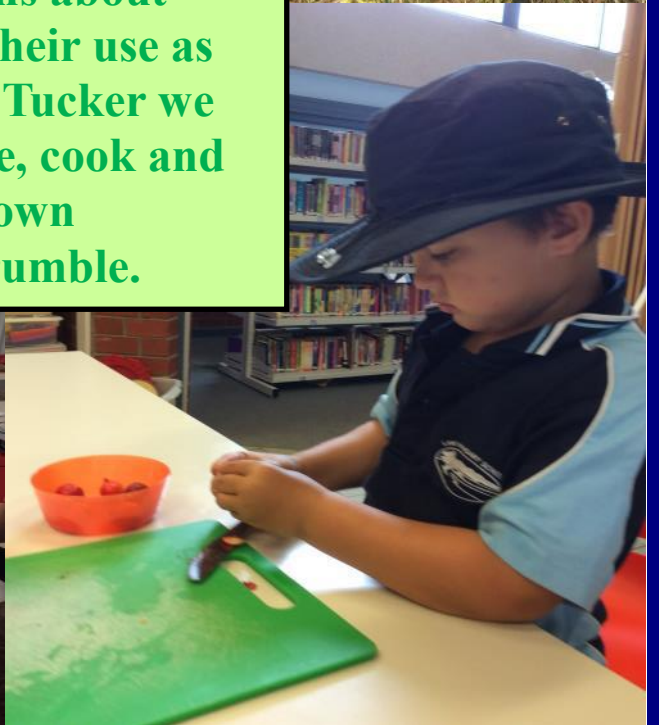




Exploring Bush Tucker
