We will have 2 more this term, in week 7 and week 10. Order forms will be sent out a week ahead, please return by Tuesday of those weeks.

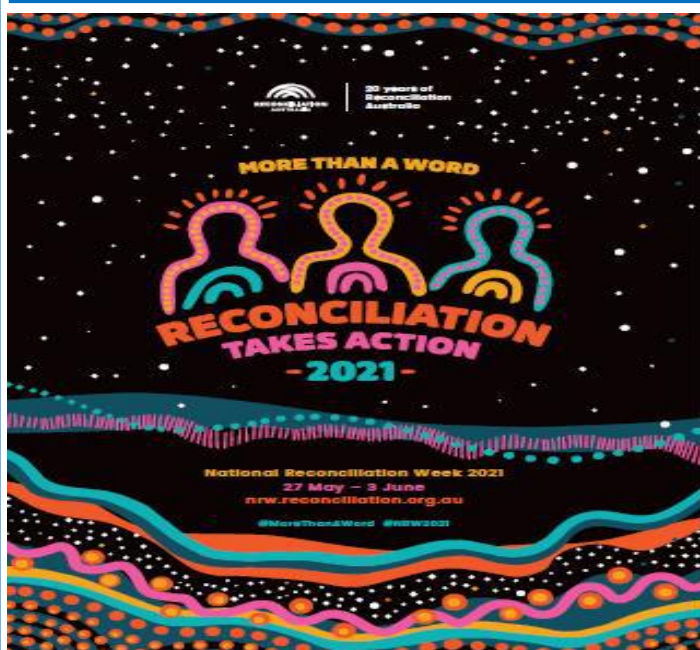


Lunchtime activities are still on Tuesdays in the kitchen, always nice to have some extra students when it's cold and wet outside.
