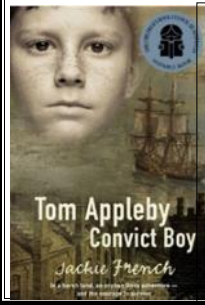
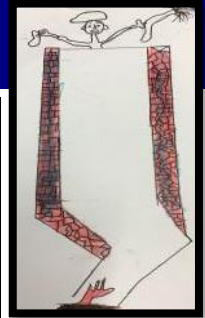


Term 2 Week 9
