Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome back! I hope you all had a great break and managed to get out when the weather was good. This term and we have so much happening we will do our best to keep you well informed and up to date.

Friday is our 100 year building celebration day. We have received many RSVPs and we are excited to hear from past scholars and employees about what life was like at school 'back in their day'. The celebration will be short, we will begin with a brief welcome followed by a tour of the school where we are encouraging students to ask what was different around the school, what has changed and how school may have been different. We are going to take many photos and capture conversations between past and present attendees. We will be asking people to share some experiences which will be led by Des Boyce. We have a huge cake and tea and coffee for everyone. We know people will want to get photos with their bricks and we are hopeful to be finished by 3:10. Hope to see you all there.

A reminder that Monday is a school closure. There will be no staff on site.

On Thursday next week we have school photos. Packages have been sent out and we need your orders back in asap. Hopefully we will have nice weather. On that day we will also be propagating seeds with Kerryn McEwan. Kerryn does some amazing work at our school and we thank her for all the support she provides. We are currently preparing to build a new shed for her and Tom near the preschool.

This term the students will be taking part in transition days. In week 3 students who will be attending Cummins Area School in 2022 have their transition days. On Monday the 25th, week 3 we have an orientation meeting for preschool parents at 9:30am. In week 4 on Tuesday the 2nd of November new preschool children will have an orientation day from 9-3. Year 6 and 7 transition is at the end of November, reminders will occur later. Preschool to school transition begins in week 5. Exciting times for students beginning a new journey in life. We look forward to being part of their journey.

The junior primary class will begin Gymnastics training in Week 3, Monday 25th October. They will have gymnastics on Mondays during weeks 3, 4, 5 and 7.

Minya Custodians is on Wednesday the 27th of October in week 3. We will be having only 2 visits this term. Our last trip to Nyroka was highly successful and students are continuing to investigate whether Woolshed Creek is a healthy habitat. It is hoped we will showcase our findings and learning at the Coffin Bay Hall later in the year (hoping to fit it in on a very full calendar!).

This year the Department for Education has developed new strategies for learning which we have implemented across the school. We have been working closely with a Literacy Coach who is supporting our knowledge of best practices and resources. We have now implemented Heggarty in the junior primary class, Spelling Mastery across the school, decodable readers (these have been great, year 1 reading results in our PAT Reading tests were amazing) and Bright Path writing. These new pedagogies are from evidence based research that illicit the best growth and development from students. Stay tuned for a more detailed letter explaining the new programs and why we are investing in these. Huge thank you to Kate Marschall our Literacy Coach from the Literacy Guarantee Unit.

A reminder that our next Governing Council meeting is on Tuesday the 26th of October at 5:30/6.00pm.

On Wednesday students have been doing mosaics with some volunteers from the Coffin Bay community. Thanks to Jayne Lane for organising all the resources and volunteers to help students. The mosaics look fantastic and we can't wait for their completion in a few weeks.

Busy times ahead and it is sure to be a great last term.

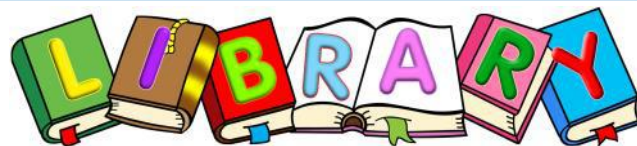

Dear parents and caregivers,

The COVID-19 pandemic has been a worrying time for all of us.

The Delta COVID-19 variant is twice as infectious as the original COVID-19 strain and there are now more cases in children and young people.

Vaccination is the best way to protect you, your family, and your friends from getting sick, and reduce the risk of outbreaks and school closures.

**I encourage everyone aged 12 years and over in your household to get vaccinated against COVID-19 as soon as possible.**

COVID-19 vaccines in Australia are safe and many millions of Australians are already protected.

The Australian Technical Advisory Group on Immunisation (ATAGI) has recommended both the Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines for people aged 12 years and over in Australia.

Consent from a parent/caregiver for COVID-19 vaccination is required for anyone under the age of 16.
