Dear Parents and Careaivers,

Welcome back! I hope everyone has had a relaxing and enjoyable break. Hearing lots of stories from students on what they did and it sounds like most people had a great time. Term 1 is set to be one of our busiest ever as we have a couple of new events occurring that will keep us all on our toes. In weeks 4 and 5 we have swimming lessons. In the past, it has only been in term 4, but students were not receiving their entitlement of hours due to outside factors out of the schools control. This year I have committed to getting their entitlements as swimming is a life skill. The Middle Primary Class will be in week 4 and Lower Primary Class in week 5.
