LIBRARY NEWS

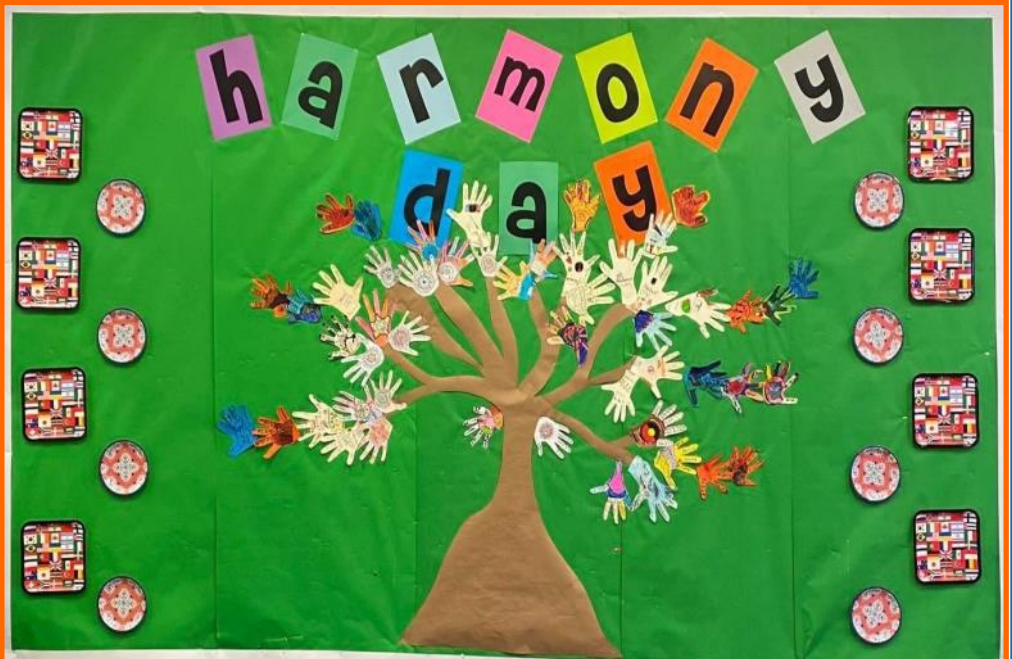


