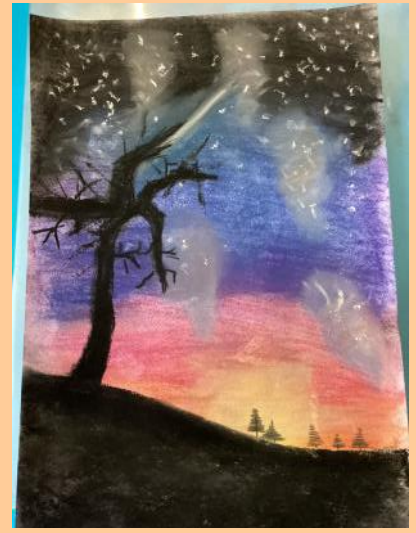




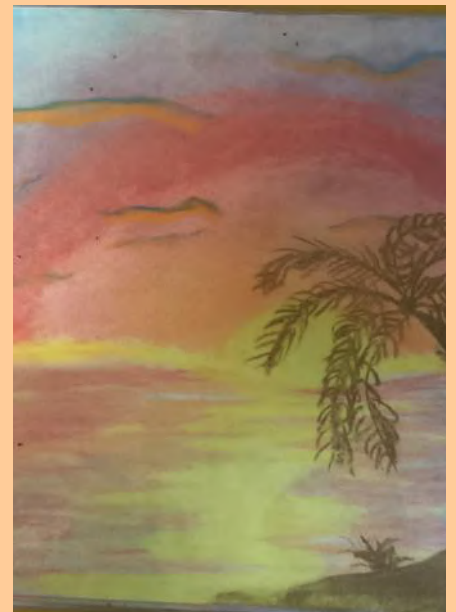
Lake Wangary School Newsletter

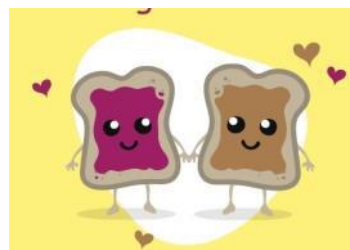
