A reminder to all parents that should a **CATASTROPHIC fire danger day** be declared by CFS this school and preschool **will be CLOSED for that predicted day**. This also means that the **bus runs are cancelled on a CATASTROPHIC day** for our site. No one is allowed on site.

If the fire risk rating changes to catastrophic during any school day our school will remain open and all transport services will operate as normal unless otherwise directed, at which times the school community will be informed. If you suspect there may be an incident threatening your child's school or preschool, **contact the Department for Education's Emergency Information Hotline on 1800 000 279**. *Schools and preschools need to keep their communication lines open so emergency services and the department can contact them to provide advice and assistance.*

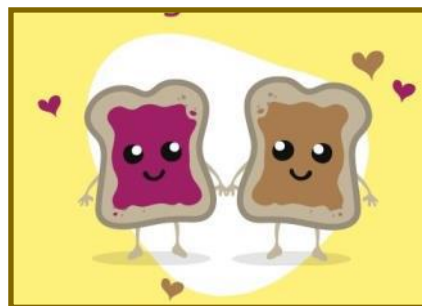
