
TERM 4 WEEK 7 - PRESCHOOL

Agency is described as: being able to make choices and decisions, to influence events and to have an impact on one's world (DEEWR, 2009, p.45). As young children grow they realise that they have the ability to contribute and make their own decisions and control their own lives. A sense of agency is a very important part of a strong sense of identity and has been identified as a foundation to learning and well-being. Educators have been encouraging and supporting children to follow through and extend their own interests and ideas.
