Principal's Message

Dear Staff, Students, Parents and Caregivers,

My name is Clint Beard and I am extremely excited about being the new Lake Wangary School Principal for the next five years. I have worked in education for 20 years having experienced teaching in the Northern Territory at the start of my career and then moving back to Eyre Peninsula in 2011. Most recently, I have been the acting principal at Poonindie Community Learning Centre, which is a similar site to Lake Wangary, where all stakeholders want to ensure the school environment is safe, supportive and rigorous for all learners. In my role as Curriculum Implementation Leader, I had the opportunity to work closely with staff at Lake Wangary and also stood in as principal for two weeks, so I am very eager to continue to build on the working relationships I have already established with staff and students.

A little about myself, my wife Megan and I have two sons, Fletcher and Samuel, who both attend Port Lincoln High School where Megan also works as a Special Educator. We are involved in the Marble Range Football Club and the North Shields Baseball Club as players and volunteers. The boys and I are very keen surfers and frequent the local breaks at Coles Point, Greenly and the Coffin Bay National Park. We spend a lot of our holiday time most recently at Coffin Bay and Dutton Bay where my family has owned a shack for over 40 years to escape the hot Lock summers. During this evening we will call for nominations for Governing Council, present our School Captains, House Captains and our SRC badges to students. Hope to see you all there.

Sports Day will be held on Thursday 28th March. I know this leads into the Easter long weekend and may be difficult for some parents to have a day off work, but with how busy Term 1 is and wanting to give our students time to prepare for the Lower Eyre Peninsula Athletics Carnival, the staff and I feel that this is our best option. This day will be held at the Marble Range Sports and Community Centre. More information will come out about this day later in the term.

Attendance is going to be a focus for 2024 and students earn points each day for attending school to go toward the House Shield presented at the end of the year. Students will also receive attendance awards at the end of each term for meeting a school target of 95% or higher attendance. There will also be a reward for the 'House' team with the most attendance points at the end of week 5 and last week of term. We want to see your child/children at school everyday for optimal learning outcomes.

What could we do?



Dear Principal and staff,

Re: School Student Broadband Initiative (SSBI)

Family finances are stretched, and sadly some students simply don't have access to a NBN service at their home. We know that access to a reliable internet service is crucial to everyday learning and further education opportunities. Without internet access, a young person's access to education can be severely compromised.

To boost education opportunities and narrow the digital divide, up to 30,000 eligible families without home internet can apply to access a free National Broadband Network (NBN) service. A family can nominate to receive a free service up to 31 December 2024. This free service will continue until 31 December 2025 for all existing and new families. Families can directly contact the National Referral Centre to have their eligibility assessed or be referred by a participating nominating organisation.

To be eligible, a family must:

- Have a child living at home that is enrolled in an Australian school.
- Have no active broadband service over the NBN network.
- Live in a premise where they can access a standard NBN service.
- Not have had an active NBN service during the previous 14 days.

To check eligibility, follow these simple steps.

- Contact the National Referral Centre, operated by Anglicare Victoria, on 1800 954 610 (Mon–Fri, 10am–6pm AEDT), www.anglicarevic.org.au/student-internet.
- The National Referral Centre team will help assess eligibility for the SSBI, by checking
 applicants' details including applicants residential address and current financial situation.
- If eligible, a voucher will be issued to be redeemed at any of the participating SSBI retail service providers. The National Referral Centre will also be available to assist with contacting your SSBI retail service provider of choice and providing follow-up support.
- If you believe you have a student/s who may benefit from this initiative, you will find
 additional information at www.infrastructure.gov.au/SSBI.
