Principal's Message

Welcome back staff and students for term 3. I hope everyone had an enjoyable two week break. It sounds like some of our staff and students had a wonderful time in warmer parts of Australia or overseas and also in Adelaide either watching the AFL or the Monster Trucks. I had a very informative conversation with one of our Preschool children regarding the Monster Trucks. He told me that his favourite monster truck was Tiger Shark because it was painted in tiger colours and that another one could not race as it had a broken back wheel. This conversation demonstrates how much information our children and students retain and the power of talking to young people has. Thank you for sharing Jethro, our discussion has certainly been a highlight of my week.

We will continue to focus on Learner Agency and co-constructed success criteria. Studies have shown that students and children who have the opportunities to share, collaborate, reflect on and explain their learning with peers and teachers have better learning growth than those who do not. We will also continue to provide our learners opportunities to have 'agency' through inquiry-based learning to discuss what they want learn and how best they learn. Class meetings and SRC will also provide further opportunities for our students and children to have a say in what they feel are important issues to address within our school.
