Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

It is hard to believe that we are already at the end of week 5, Term 3. The days and weeks are just flying by. This week is SSO Week. Week 5 was also Book Week. We celebrated this with a costume parade on Tuesday 20th August. There were some terrific costumes from both students and staff members. The 3/4 class, Mrs. Morgan, Merridy and Mr. Rowe had a terrific 2 days on camp in week 4, which included an excursion to Port Lincoln in preparation for their overnight stay at Nyroca. Ms. Morgan gave the students the task of preparing and costing a shopping list for their breakfast, lunch and dinners for camp. This task promotes collaboration, problem solving and peer-to-peer feedback which are key elements of Learner Agency, which is one of our site's improvement focuses. Talking to the students they all had a fantastic time and all staff members were ready for a well-earned rest over the weekend.

Learner Agency has been a focus in all classes specifically in the learning area of mathematics. Ms. Priscilla and the Foundation students are working toward sharing their learning with one another and explaining their thinking to the group. This has been beneficial with the student's recognising patterns and identifying if it is repeating or not. Mrs. Clarke and the 1/2's are also focusing on explaining their thinking with their peers. This has provided opportunities for students to share their own problem-solving strategies and peer-to-peer teaching moments. Mrs. Freeman and the 5/6's have been engaged in mathematical problems with no immediate solution. They were tasked with making a variety of different nets for 3-dimensional shapes and then had to prove that they worked by constructing them out of newspaper. All of these strategies are helping us toward our goal to embed Learner Agency at Lake Wangary School.

If you did not receive an email or SMS with your unique survey link by Friday 9th August 2024, please check your spam or junk email folders.





Does your child have OCD?



Has your child been diagnosed with Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder, OR experienced unwanted, intrusive thoughts, and perform certain behaviours over and over again to prevent those thoughts from coming true?

Researchers at Macquarie University are investigating the needs of families of children aged 4-18 with OCD from minority backgrounds.
